Monthly Update April 2014

Maintenance Dredging

Maintenance Dredging has been completed in Pelican, Petrel, Cormorant, Sandpiper, Walkers C k, Skua and Curlew Canals.

The dredge is currently off site, however, dredging will recommence in Kingfisher Canal mid April 2014.

Beach Profiling

End of March: 47 lots completed with 39 lots remaining.

Griffith Road Pond

The Griffith Road spoil pond is now full. Water will be released allowing the material to dry out. Once an appropriate consistency is achieved the material will be loaded into to s and taken from site.

Disposal work is expected to commence June 2014 and is expected to be completed March 2015, weather permitting.

The construction team will be on site during the hours of 7.00am and 5:30pm weekdays.

Griffith Road Pond Work Methods

In response to feedback provided after the last round of dredging, additional measures will be undertaken to minimise impact to adjoining property owners.

Dust

Gravel has been placed on the haulage routes to minimise dust.

Noise and Vibration

The construction methodology has been altered to ensure construction noise and vibration levels are well below levels stated in conditions of approval.

Screening

Additional trees have been planted along the boundary to provide further screening.
